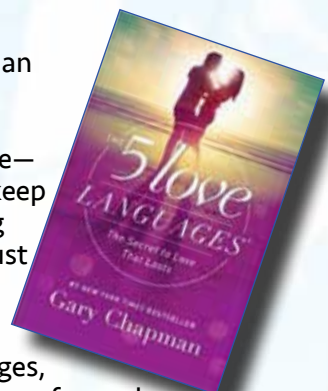

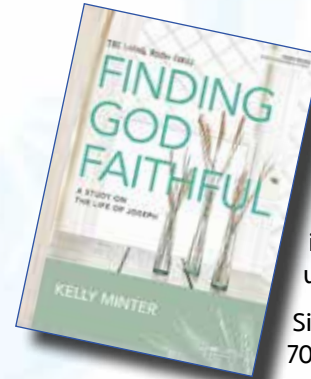

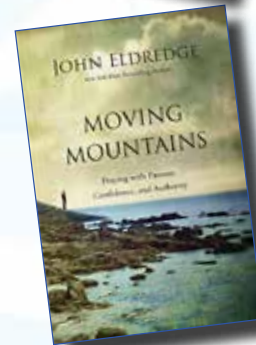


TUESDAY
