- 1st Qtr:**
- 1) Global support approved for Sam Desir through Bethany International for 16-months (August, 2019 - November, 2020) of mission training in Ghana at \$300 per month (\$900/Qtr).
  - 2) Local support for Ruth Meiers Hospitality House was discontinued as the facility is now operated by Lutheran Social Services of Fargo, and the mission has been changed.
  - 3) Local one-time disbursements totaling \$601 were made to Child Evangelism Fellowship (\$301), and to People Matter (\$300).
- 2nd Qtr:**
- 1) Global one-time disbursement of \$825 for Ben Hershey through Bethlehem Baptist for Thailand mission trip.
  - 2) Local one-time disbursements totaling \$1,800 to Family Policy Alliance of ND (\$900), and to the Women's Care Clinic in Bismarck (\$900).
  - 3) Received notice that One More, One Less is ending their adoption ministry.
- 3rd Qtr:**
- 1) Applications for ongoing support were received by Revival Prayer Fellowship and Family Policy Alliance of ND. Those applications are still under consideration.
  - 2) Global one-time disbursement of \$430 made to the Lutheran Church of South Sudan.
  - 3) The following local one-time disbursements were made for a total of \$2,081: Revival Prayer Fellowship (\$750); Family Policy Alliance of ND (\$750); Awaken the Dawn (\$291); Women's Care Network (\$290).
- 4th Qtr:**
- 1) \$1,500 one-time disbursement to the Family Policy Foundation under Global Programs.
  - 2) Added Revival Prayer Fellowship to Local Programs. Removed Ruth Meiers Hospitality House from Local Programs.
  - 3) An additional \$600 to each of the first 3 Mission Pledges (\$1,800) noted towards top of the report; \$600 disbursement to Charity's ministry expense to McLaughlin, SD; \$1,309 disbursement to CEF (Child Evangelism Fellowship)- \$250 for banquet/ \$1,059 for the SW Chapter, for a total of \$3,709 in one-time disbursements under Local Programs.
